The cost of the day will be £15, payable in advance by PayPal. If for some reason you can't register beforehand you can still pay in cash on the day.

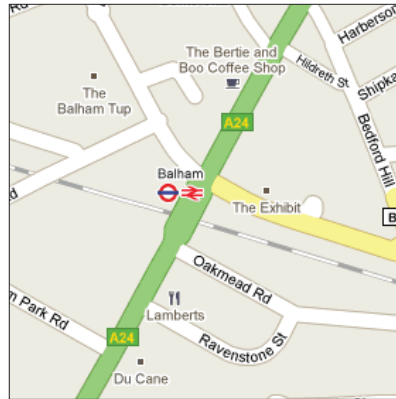

Balham takes about 15 - 20 minutes from London Victoria, either by underground or overground. The Exhibit is a 30 second walk from the Station.
